

Important insurance information for you. Please read carefully and ask any questions. We want you to be clear about what your insurance policy covers and what your payment responsibility is.

1. Is your insurance in force? Yes No

Check your insurance to make sure it is current.
If not you will be responsible for the payment of the charges.

2. Do you have more than one insurance? Yes No

The primary insurance will be billed first.
The secondary insurance would be billed, for the balance,
not paid by primary insurance.

3. What type of insurance does the patient have? Medical Hospital

Some insurances only cover charges for hospital care.
Check that your insurance covers charges in specialist's office.
Your insurance company book will have that information or call your
Insurance company or employer's benefits officer.

4. What is your deductible amount? \$ _____

This is the amount of money you pay before your insurance would pay.
This amount is per person per year covered by the insurance policy.

5. Is the deductible applicable for all services? Yes No

If no, what services does it apply to (for example office visit, tests or injections)?

6. Have you paid the deductible amount this year? Yes No

If no, we expect you to pay this amount at the time of visit. Please be prepared.

7. Do you know what percentage of the charges insurance would cover? Yes No

Insurance companies usually cover 80 to 90 % of the charges, which means you would
be responsible for the balance. Please be aware of it and be prepared to pay that.

8. Do you have a co-payment? Yes No

This is the amount you pay at the time of the visit.

9. Is the referral or precertification needed for Allergy/Asthma services. Yes No

Some insurances require this for office visits, surgery or hospitalization.

10 Is the insurance coverage less than a year old? Yes No

Some insurances cover preexisting condition for a specific period
Usually 6-12 months from the effective date of the insurance.
